

Support Your School - Saline Scrip

As a reminder, Saline Scrip is simply gift certificates from hundreds of local and national businesses. These businesses sell the gift certificates to the parent/teacher organizations at a discount; the PTA sells them to you for face value. The PTA gets the difference, on average about 6 – 8% of the purchase.

Here are a few more benefits of the program:

- There are no added fees -- you pay only the face value of the certificate you order.
- You can order from Saline Scrip as often or as infrequently as you like.
- You can use the certificates at any participating retailer anywhere nationwide, including paying off your store credit card, unless otherwise listed on the order form.
- There is a quick turn-around between placing and receiving your order. Order forms and payment sent to school by Thursday are returned for pick up or to be sent home with your child on the following Thursday.
- In most cases, you will receive the same gift card that is available in the store.
- Your order can be sent home with your child – please sign the release form on the reverse side of this page and return it to school with your first order.
