

S.W.W.C. Student Building Trades Program, Inc. **Scholarship Program**

The S.W.W.C. Student Building Trades Program, Inc. is a non-profit corporation established to provide technical assistance and advice to the South and West Washtenaw Consortium Building Trades Program, in which the Chelsea, Dexter, Manchester, Milan and Saline Public School Districts participate. One of the corporation's goals is to provide scholarships and awards to student participants in the Building Trades Program to foster and encourage further career and technical education in construction and the building trades. To that end, the corporation has established the "S.W.W.C. Student Building Trades Scholarship Program".

Under the Scholarship Program, two (2) \$500.00 one-time scholarships will be awarded annually to students who have completed the South and West Washtenaw Consortium Building Trades Program to be applied toward or reimburse the students for post-secondary educational expenses in a construction-related or building trade-related field.

Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who have completed the Student Building Trades Program whom the Board of Directors, in their discretion, determines best satisfies the following criteria:

1. Ability and performance in the Building Trades Program and other course work
2. Financial need
3. Motivation and desire of the student to pursue a career in a construction-related field

Application Process

Students interested in applying for the scholarship should complete an application and submit it to their high school guidance office, which will transfer it to the Consortium office. Applications should be submitted no later than April 15th. Applicants should submit a resume with their application. Students are invited to submit any additional information they feel will help the Board in making the award decision. The Board shall seek input from the Building Trades Program instructor and the student's high school counselor, and may interview applicants.

Payment of Scholarship

Payment of scholarship funds will be made directly to the educational institution in which the student enrolls, or may, in the Board's discretion, be paid directly to the student upon receipt of proof of payment of tuition, fees or other educational expenses.
