Dear Families:

The Jumpstart summer program is provided for struggling students to help them learn and improve the skills necessary to be successful in school. Daily attendance is mandatory for students who qualify for the Jumpstart program. The program runs five days a week for three weeks.

The 2009 summer schedule is July 20-August 7, from 8:30-11:30 am.

Students qualify by meeting one or more of the following criteria:

- ◆ Receive a minimum of 2 Ds or an E in any core class (language arts, math, science, and/or social studies)
- ◆ A downward trend in student achievement resulting in failing grades

Student performance will be reviewed every trimester. If your child meets the above criteria you will receive a letter of notification that your child may be required or is required to attend the Jumpstart program. Failure to attend or successfully complete the Jumpstart program may result in an alternative school setting, reduced elective choices, or a mandatory study skills class in place of an elective.
